In training all HAI'sians to be leaders, all Sec 1 students will attend a student leadership module entitled "Knowing Myself and Others". Students will learn to identify their strengths and areas for growth, as well as to respect and accept others. This module will take place during curriculum time.

b. LLP Module (Collaborating with Others) for selected Student Leaders [1 Jun]

New student councillors and nominated student leaders from class committees and CCA committees will attend a student leadership module that will enable them to learn collaborative skills and to bring out the strengths of self and others when working in a team. In this module, student leaders will learn to communicate ideas clearly and challenge ideas constructively.





6. Retreat for Catholic Students [31 May & 1 Jun]

The school is collaborating with youth leaders from Christ the King Church to organise a retreat on 31 May and 1 June 2018 for our Catholic students. Catholic students will undergo leadership training and hear from an invited speaker (architect who designed Novena Church) how he had infused the Catholic faith in his profession.

The Sec 1 Inter-house Games are organized by our PE teachers to enhance camaraderie and bonding within the classes and the houses as a whole. It is also aimed at instilling the competitive spirit and to promote interest in sports.

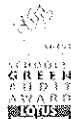
8. Temperature Taking Exercise [29 Jun]

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
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
