RE: **Sexuality Education (SEd) Programme in 2019**

MOE's sexuality education programme is premised on the importance of the family and respect for the values and beliefs of the different ethnic and religious communities on sexuality issues. The aim is to help pupils make responsible values-based choices on matters involving sexuality.

Sexuality Education in schools is covered both in the formal curriculum and co-curricular programmes. The formal curriculum subjects in which topics on sexuality are incorporated include Science and Character and Citizenship Education (CCE).

MOE's Growing Years (GY) is the main co-curricular package. It is developmental in nature, spanning the upper primary to post-secondary (JC/CI) levels. It addresses the subject of human sexuality from a holistic perspective, involving the intellectual, emotional, social, physical and ethical aspects of sexuality. It is covered under four main themes: Human Development, Interpersonal Relationships, Sexual Health and Behaviour, and Society and Culture.

Hai Sing Catholic School, being a Catholic school, uses Franciscan values as the basis in the inculcation of positive values and attitudes towards sexuality, so that pupils develop a respect for themselves and others, in line with the national value of family as the basic unit of society.

Thus, the teaching of Sexuality Education is based on the given guiding principles set by the Ministry of Education, integrated with the teaching of values such as Integrity and Compassion and the Catholic ethos of Pro-life (which equates to that of respect for life).
